

Faculty Assessment Orientation

The college-wide Academic Senate Assessment Committee (ASAC) conducts assessment orientation programs designed to familiarize new and continuing faculty members with the evolving practices of student learning outcomes assessment at Nassau Community College. This professional development event has been held annually since the 2002-2003 academic year. It provides exposure to the various learning outcomes assessment policies, processes and practices at the College to guide faculty members in achieving continuous improvement in their own assessment practices for courses, programs and departments.

The Faculty Assessment Orientation program includes presentations made by NCC faculty and administrators who have experience in assessment, along with a question and answer session which enables the attendees to engage in discussions with current members of the Academic Senate Assessment Committees. The annual program has proven very beneficial in conveying to new and experienced faculty members the importance of student learning outcomes assessment, and in helping them to understand their responsibilities regarding planning and implementation of their own assessment designs.

The most recent Faculty Assessment Orientation was held on Friday, February 26, 2016. Information concerning the next Faculty Assessment Orientation will be posted when available. All recently hired faculty members are strongly encouraged to attend, as well as other faculty members who may not have previously had the opportunity to attend an orientation or who are interested in a “brush-up”.
