PHYSICAL THERAPIST ASSISTANT Deadline - Last Friday in February	AHS2	AAS	‡	No evening program. Fall admission only. Freshmen (1) Upper 50% of high school class. (2) Grades of 75 or above in H.S. bio., chem., and 2 yrs. of college preparatory math.; (3) Written proof from a physical therapist or asst., on facility stationery, of a minimum of 10 hrs. volunteer or paid work experience in a physical therapy setting. Transfers: (1) Grade of "C" or better in lab. sci. course for sci. majors (pref. Anat. & Phys. I); completion of at least 12 lib. arts credits from PTA program, with GPA of 2.5 or above. If chemistry was not taken in high school, a semester of introductory college chemistry is required, and may be counted as part of the required "12 liberal arts credits." (2) Documentation of vol. exp. [see #3 above]. All transfer applicants must be in good academic standing at previous college. All Applicants: Placement in remediation may remove applicant from consideration. Interview required.

Placement in remediation may remove applicant from consideration. Interview required. Transfers: In addition, recommend completion of ENG 101, a MAT elective and a lab science

Freshmen: Upper 50% of high school class. 1 yr. biology, 1 yr. chemistry or physics; 2 yrs. of college preparatory math; min. grades of 78 in sci. & math. Minimum 2 hrs. clinical observation in general radiology required, prior to interview; documentation by facility required on facility stationery. Placement in remediation may remove applicant from consideration. Transfers: Must have a minimum 2.75 cumulative GPA. Interview may be required.
